Hello from the K-5th Griffin Library!

Library starts this week, with Intermediate and Primary students rotating each week for their library visits. I can't wait to see all of them! These first few weeks will be filled with going over procedures, library etiquette, and reading some really fun stories.

A few notes for you, as parents, and a vital part of the 3-legged stool:

A. Checking out books:

1. Students in Kindergarten will checkout (1) book per visit, but they will keep the book in their classroom.
2. 1st Grade students will checkout (1) book per visit, and they may bring it home if they wish.
3. 2nd-5th Grade students will be able to checkout up to (2) books per visit, and the books will travel to and from school with them. (We have limited inventory and serve over 1,000 students in this library, so this is why we limit it to 1-2 books per student.)

B. Book Fines/Book Replacement Fees:

1. There will not be fines if your student doesn't return a book by the due date. Instead, they will not be able to checkout a book until that book is returned.
2. If a book is lost, or so severely damaged that it cannot be repaired, then the book will need to be replaced. Please email Mrs. Huntley at jennifer.huntley@acaedu.net if your student needs to replace a book.
